Monday	<p>SPAG - Paper 1 grammar and punctuation SPAG Paper 2 spellings</p> <p><i>"In SPAG we learn about conjunctions, parenthesis, verb forms, clauses, different types of punctuation and other types of grammar. We have to complete sentences, underline words, tick boxes, circle words and identify features."</i></p> <p><i>"In spellings we have 20 words which come from the key words for Y5 and Y6. We use 'cover, write, check' to learn the spellings."</i></p>
Tuesday	<p>Reading comprehension</p> <p><i>"We have to read three texts and answer different questions. We identify information from each text. There are different types of questions, including retrieval, inference, between the lines and three mark PEE questions."</i></p>
Wednesday and Thursday	<p>Maths Paper 1 Arithmetic Maths Paper 2 Reasoning Maths Paper 3 Reasoning</p> <p><i>"Arithmetic covers fractions, times tables, long division, multiplication, place value, all four operations and BODMAS!"</i></p> <p><i>"Reasoning covers word problems, missing numbers, diagrams, ordering, shapes and measures, data handling and other mathematics."</i></p>
