Daily expectations for remote learning

It is important that your child fully engages with our remote learning timetable in order to support their progress and development while schools remain closed. Education is not optional. We understand that this will be a challenge for some families who may be balancing working from home and supporting their children with home learning. As a school we are here to assist you wherever as we possibly can, and your continued support is greatly appreciated. The next section sets out expectations for engaging with and completing home learning throughout the school day.

- **Google Meet calls** – morning and afternoon registration, live lessons and Collective Worship will take place on Google Meet calls. Children join these through the calendar on

their Google Classroom class page. For further guidance on how to do this, see our "Online Learning Guidance" document.

Please note that links to Google Meet calls will be posted a few minutes before the session is due to begin, and will be deleted once the lesson has ended.

- **Registration** – the register is taken twice a day; in the morning and after lunch. Please check the registration time on your child's timetable and ensure that they arrive promptly. If you experience problems logging in, please call the office to register your child. If your child is ill and unable to attend their remote lessons that day, please contact the office as soon as possible.
- **Daily lessons** – children will have an English, Mathematics and Foundation Subject lesson each day. This will comprise of a 30-minute live lesson with their class teacher followed by a 30-minute independent activity linked to the teaching. Children are expected to attend all lessons and to complete the independent activity during the time allocated. Completed work must be uploaded to Google Classroom by **8am** the following morning. All work will then be checked by the class teacher and returned electronically by **4pm**.
- **Oxford Reading Buddy** – children must log into Oxford Reading Buddy daily and should read *at least one book* at their current level. They must then complete the quiz linked to the book. It is important that your child selects a book at the level set by their teacher in order to ensure appropriate challenge. This activity will be completed independently, but teachers will check quiz scores daily and will move children on as soon as they are ready. To learn more about Oxford Reading Buddy [click here](#).
- **Mathematics activities** – teachers will assign activities for children to complete on Mathletics. Children must complete at least one assigned activity each day, and can then click on the 'Play' tab to explore games for further practice. For a helpful video on navigating the Mathletics platform [click here](#). Additionally, children can use Numbots and TT Rockstars to practise their number bonds and times tables. The mathematics activities will be completed independently, but teachers will check scores daily.
- **P.E.** – it is important that children participate in daily physical activity daily in order to keep their minds and bodies healthy. If you are able to access an outdoor space in which to exercise safely then this would be ideal. Alternatively, we have provided some ideas for exercising indoors. Go Noodle features 100s of fun movement and mindfulness videos for kids, and Cosmic Yoga also offers a wide range of yoga and mindfulness videos designed specifically for children.
- **Collective Worship** – this is an opportunity for us to gather together as a school community at the end of the day. Collective Worship will be led by Miss Slater and all members of the school community are encouraged to attend.
